



1. Purpose

The School of St Jude Limited in Australia ("SOSJ-A") is committed to taking all reasonable efforts to ensure that the funds it sends to The School of St Jude - (see Sc) is committed to taking appropriate precautions are in place.

3. Anti-terrorism

- SOSJ-A shall undertake regular project visits by at least one representative of the
- SOSJ-A shall obtain regular updates in relation to the avoidance of terrorism with its International
- Each assessment and approval of a specific project, including checking against sanctioned individuals and financing, and
- All grant payments shall be made to the beneficiaries and administered by the organisation.
- SOSJ-A shall maintain records of all transactions.

- SOSJ-A shall monitor and evaluate the activities carried out by International Partners to ensure that grants are expended on the purpose for which they are given.
- Where the Board of SOSJ-A has assessed an International Partner at high risk of Terrorism Financing, extra precautions will be put in place by the Board.
- Any suspicious activity will be notified to the Directors of SOSJ-A immediately.
